Roketsan conducts its activities in accordance with Türkiye's policies and shares the humanitarian concerns of Türkiye regarding the indiscriminate use of these types of weapons.

Roketsan confidently states that neither Roketsan nor its affiliates are involved and intend to be involved in the future, in any form of *Production, Development, Integration, Maintenance, Sales, Life Extension, Distribution, Stocking Import / Export, Transfer, Relocation (or Moving), Usage (or Use)* of cluster weapons and / or munitions, anti-personnel mines, chemicals, biological and depleted uranium weapons.
